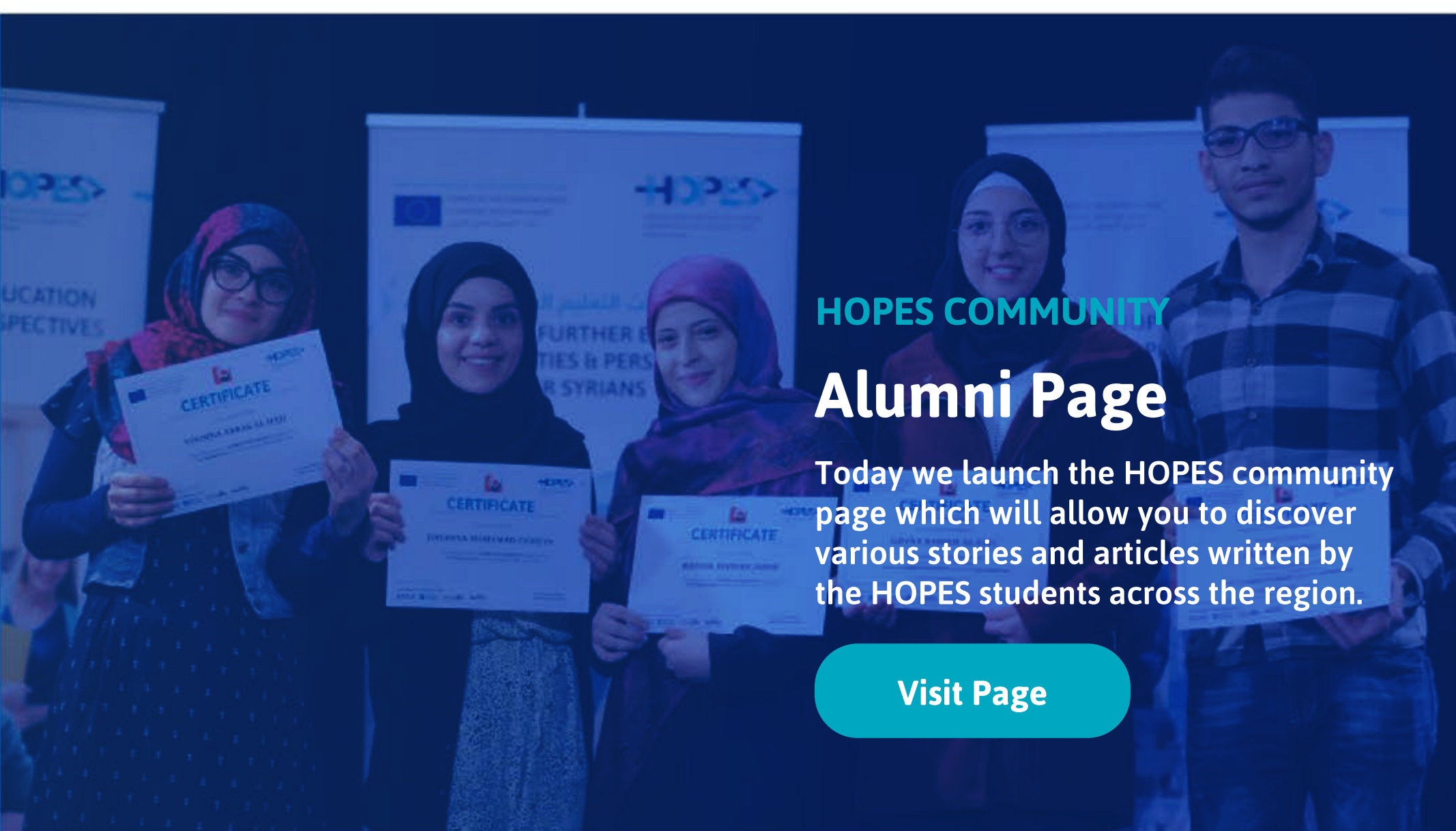

Your support has allowed us to provide 620 full academic scholarships and more than 8,500 university-based English courses and 400 IELTS courses and tests, as well as academic counselling to more than 26,000 prospective students. In addition, 20 national stakeholder dialogues and 2 regional conferences were organised and 32 innovative short-term education projects were funded reaching an estimate of 36,400 refugees and vulnerable young people.

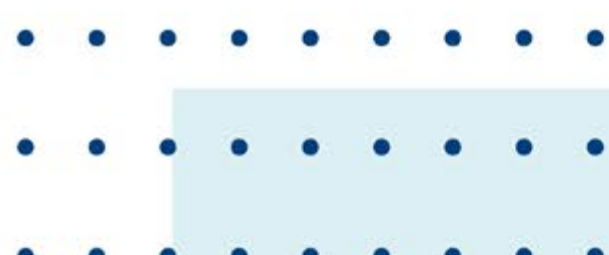
