

LOST's MISSION




Work with people, particularly women and youth to create a more developed and equitable society through reducing poverty, eliminating exclusion, and fostering a culture of peace.

LOST is headed by a general manager of the organization in charge of setting its vision and goals with the board and also of overseeing the executive managers with the assistance of the deputy manager.


Administration also oversees a team of nine branch coordinators, each of whom is in charge of leading a sub-regional branch of LOST.




