# REFLECTIONS FROM THE LEAD INSTITUTION

Together for Better Higher Education was an innovative project that contributed to the strengthening of the collaboration between our organisation with public and private institutions.

Students were able to benefit from practical and market skills in three university majors, in Accounting, Web Development and Nursing, during a time where educational institutes were closed due to economic crises and Covid-19 restrictions and students were unable to attend their regular classes in their universities or their vocational institutes. Despite all challenges faced, we were able through this project to provide capacity building courses in English, IT, and career guidance as well as psychosocial support to reduce the crises' effects.

During implementation, the team had to find practical and mitigation measures to the various challenges faced whether electricity outage, the increase in the fuel costs and the scarcity of resources or the Covid-19 restrictions. A key measure was the reallocation of resources in the most cost effective and optimized ways.

The announcement and promotion of the project through various social media channels was crucial for a successful and bigger outreach to a significant number of interested applicants. This is definitely one of the main lessons learned and a good practice to be used in the outreach process in our future projects. We celebrated the graduation of 159 fully capacitated students with the required market skills and strong personality which reflects the importance of such projects to build and support their future.
